



ADDENDUM TO RENTAL AGREEMENT

At the request of the Sierra Club Seal Society, this addendum is added to the Rental Agreement used by the La Jolla Cove Bridge Club at Ellen Browning Scripps Park to draw attention to the Tenants of the year-round presence of the Sea Lion Rookery and the City regulations.

The La Jolla Cove Bridge Club is located on public park land. The Tenant agrees to abide by any rules and/or regulations imposed by the City of San Diego.

In consideration of the Sea Lion Rookery and City rules, please do not:

- (1) Approach or disturb the sea lions, such as making loud noises directed at them;
- (2) Shine lights from cameras and phones in their face;
- (3) Bring dogs on Point La Jolla or Boomer Beach as it is illegal;
- (4) Climb over the sidewalk wall to enter the rookery;
- (5) Use balloons in the building or the park. They are not allowed and may end up in the ocean;
- (6) Take wedding or other photos on the ocean side of the wall as they are not permitted during the closure period of May 1 to October 31. They are also not allowed during the non-closure period if there is the chance of disturbing resting sea lions. This means, altering their behavior such as causing them to flee or move, bark or bite.
